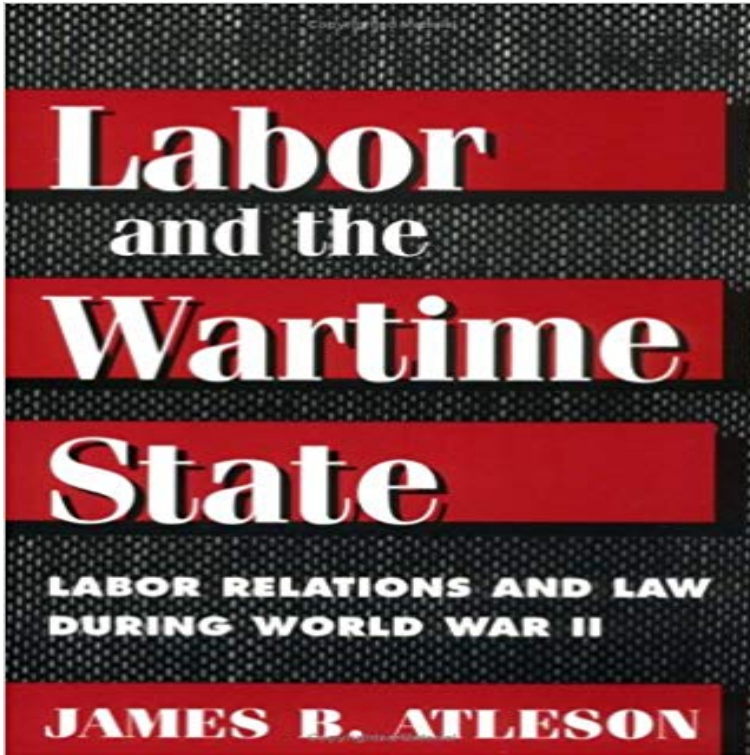


LABOR & WARTIME STATE: Labor Relations and Law during World War II
